



Student Online Learning Orientation (SOLO)

What is the SOLO?

SOLO is a Student Online Learning Orientation that is delivered completely online in TSTC's Learning Management System, Moodle.

What is the Purpose of the SOLO?

The purpose of the SOLO is to increase your awareness, readiness and self-confidence in taking online learning courses at TSTC.

Who Has to Take the SOLO?

You are required to take and successfully complete the SOLO if you:

- Have not taken and passed a TSTC online course in the past two years (with a grade of C or better) *
- Have not taken and passed the SOLO

How Can You Access the SOLO?

- The SOLO can be accessed from any computer with an internet connection
- Log on to the TSTC Moodle site at: <http://mycourses.tstc.edu>
- You will see SOLO 0100 listed as one of your courses
- Click on it to begin

What is Required to Successfully Complete the SOLO?

- Depending on your comfort level with technology, completion of the orientation can range from 1-4 hours. The course does not have to be completed in one "sitting. You can complete certain course items then come back to the orientation later to complete the rest.
- To successfully pass the SOLO you must complete all SOLO assignments and obtain a final average of 80 percent or better.
